Policy	This policy aims to support Alumni, First Nations families and students who are passionate about accessing a Steiner Education for their child and for whom parent contributions may be inaccessible.		
Eligibility Criteria	 All applications for bursaries will be based on financial need of the applying family and a dedication to the philosophy of the school and Anthroposophy. Applications will fall into three categories: Alumni Bursaries - Students whose parents attended Samford Valley Steiner School (for more than four years). First Nations Bursaries - Students who identify as a First Nation person of Australia. Strong Supporter of the School – Families who have shown strong commitment to the school or Anthroposophy. 		
Bursary Allocation	 The allocation of bursaries will be determined by a dedicated Assessment Committee which will consist of: School Director Alumni representative and/or Life member of the Association First Nations Partnership, Cultural Advisor

	The Assessment Committee ewill review applications before the commencement of the school year and assess eligibility based on the established criteria for each category of bursaries. The committee may consider factors such as financial need, commitment to the school, and personal circumstances in making allocation decisions. The number and amount of bursaries awarded each year will depend on the available
	funds and the number of eligible applicants. The committee will endevour to facilitate fair and equitable distribution of bursaries among eligible applicants that have a current enrolment contract or offer of a place.
Application Process:	Application forms for each category of bursaries will be made available through the Samford Valley Steiner School's website and on Parent Lounge. The application period and deadline will be clearly communicated to all eligible students and families. Applicants will be required to submit relevant documentation, including financial
	information and any additional information requested by the Bursary Committee. All applications and supporting documents will be treated with strict confidentiality.
Reporting	Target fundraising revenue and annual budget will form part if the annual budget approved by the Board. Financial reporting for the Community Bursary fund will be included in the Board financial reports on a 6 monthly basis. Report to the community will be in a deidentified way so that the community can understand the benefit /impact of the fundraising effort.
Review and Renewal	Bursaries will be awarded on an annual basis, subject to the availability of funds and the student's continued eligibility. To be granted the funds, eligible applicants will need to apply every year by the submission date.
Fundraising and Donations	Samford Valley Steiner School will actively seek partnerships, grants, and donations from individuals, organisations, and businesses to support the Community Bursary Program.
	Where a donation is made to the fund a DGR receipt will be provided to the donor.
