#### Remuneration

Teacher rate according to qualifications and length of service

#### **Hours of Duty**

This is a permanent part-time position, initially 12 hours per week, days and hours to be negotiated.

## **Key Responsibilities**

The High School Literacy and Numeracy Learning Enrichment Teacher supports students with additional learning needs or those requiring extension, and liaises with the assistants, teachers and parents. The role involves working with students on a one on one or small group basis, either in the Enrichment/study room or in classrooms to support students and teachers

The need to work intuitively, confidentially and manage a range of tasks is vital. Clear communication and documentation skills are essential.

Some pastoral care support to the students may be provided by developing a relationship of respect and trust.
