Role Context

Samford Valley Steiner School (SVSS) was established in 1987 and has experienced considerable growth over the past few years, with a High School operating since 2006. The School operates from a wellestablished and strong base in Anthroposophy that permeates all aspects of school. As a consequence of the growth in the school, we have identified a need for a Literacy and Numeracy Learning Enrichment Teacher who will promote and maintain positive relationships with students, staff, colleagues, parents and the school community.

The Literacy and Numeracy Learning Enrichment Teacher must be willing to learn, engage and work from our Vision and Core Principles at Samford Valley Steiner School. https://www.samfordsteiner.gld.edu.au/about-us/vision/

This role supports students with additional learning needs or those requiring extension, and liaises with the assistants, teachers and parents under the direction of the Learning Enrichment Coordinators. The role involves working with students on a one on one or small group basis. The role requires the ability to create different pathways for groups of students in collaboration with Class Teachers and the Learning Enrichment Coordinators. The role may require developing support programs for students that teacher aides can oversee.

Role Purpose

The overarching goal is to support students to achieve literacy and numeracy proficiency, with the goal of inclusive education.

The Literacy and Numeracy Learning Enrichment Teacher will provide support to students with Literacy and Numeracy challenges and teach students from classes 4 to 7 and working closely with the Class Teachers, Learning Enrichment Coordinators, Primary School Director and specialist teachers.

Referral to the Learning Enrichment program will be overseen by the Learning Enrichment Coordinator in collaboration with the Primary School Director, Class Teachers, and parents.

Key Accountabilities



Working collaboratively with the Learning Enrichment Coordinators, teachers, admin and the Primary School Director in supporting students with additional learning needs. This includes:

- An ability to develop positive and professional relationships with students
- Working to reduce barriers to learning and enhance the quality and opportunity of the school experience for students, by interfacing where appropriate, between student/family/school, to achieve the greatest learning potential possible.
- Providing support and feedback on the teaching of students with learning needs and those requiring extension.
- Collaboration with Class Teachers and Learning Enrichment team to contribute additional expertise in planning, teaching, assessing and monitoring student achievement and progress.
- Developing useful teaching and assessment resources for each year level so that teachers can use these within their own teaching.
- Keeping programs and assessment records on the School Portal.
- Providing support to teacher aides, and Class Teachers
- Advocating for students where there is disadvantage, and to liaise with teachers around academic issues and provide support, in consultation with the Learning Enrichment Coordinator around referrals.
- Supporting teachers by updating information on the School Adjustment Plan (SAP) in collaboration with teachers and the Learning Enrichment Coordinators.
- Keeping accurate documentation of program delivery including NCCD requirements.
- Working inclusively so that all students have the opportunity to be in their class and receive additional support as required but recognising and advocating for students who may prefer a quiet working space outside the classroom too.
- Participating in professional development opportunities.
