

Restorative Practices

3 Day Facilitator Training

with Marg Thorsborne

This workshop will explore a paradigm shift in thinking about the responses to incidents of difficult behaviour – from the most serious and challenging incidents which would attract suspensions or exclusion through to the responses to minor incidents in classrooms and the playground. It is based on the philosophy and principles of restorative justice as they apply to educational settings.

The workshop is limited to 30 participants and is designed to train school leadership and pastoral/behaviour teams and teachers in the use of restorative practices. It would be best if schools can send more than one staff member.
