Information for Applicants

Remuneration

Above the State Award and dependent upon experience and qualifications.

Hours of Duty

This is a permanent part-time contract position of 0.6 FTE from 1 January 2020.

Probation

There is a 6 month probationary period.

Qualifications

Must have teacher registration in Queensland or be eligible to apply. Degree in Special Education desirable but not essential if teaching experience in a Special Education setting.

- 2. Statements, which concisely but fully describe how you consider yourself suitable against each of the selection criteria.
- 3. The names, positions and telephone contact numbers for at least two referees who can comment on your suitability for the position.

ROLE CONTEXT

Samford Valley Steiner School (SVSS) was established in 1987 and has experienced considerable growth over the past few years, with a High School operating since 2006. The School operates from a well-established and strong base in Anthroposophy that permeates all aspects of school. As a consequence of the growth in the primary school, we have identified a need for a **Special Education** Teacher who will promote and maintain positive relationships with students, staff, colleagues, parents and the school community.

This role supports students with additional needs, such as those with emotional, behavioural and social needs, and liaises with teachers and parents. The role involves working with students on a one on one or small group basis, either in the Enrichment room or in class rooms to support students and teachers. The role also requires supervision of teacher aides in the Enrichment Program and contribution to the NCCD.

ROLE PURPOSE

The overarching goal is to support students and staff, and parents in the form of additional support, with the goal of inclusive education and meeting the needs of students according to their developmental level as described by Rudolf Steiner.

The **Special Education** Teacher will teach identified students from classes 1 to 7 as requested by the Enrichment Coordinators or as requested by the primary School EA, School Director or teachers.

Referral to the Enrichment program will be overseen by the Primary School Education Administrator in collaboration with the Enrichment Coordinator and parents.

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Working collaboratively with the teachers, the Primary School Education Administrator and the Enrichment Coordinators in supporting students with additional needs. This includes:

- Working to reduce barriers to learning and enhance the quality and opportunity of the school experience for students with additional needs, by interfacing where appropriate, between student/family/school, to achieve the greatest learning potential possible.
- Working with students in remedial literacy and numeracy, as well as visual cues as required.
- To advocate for students where there is disadvantage, and to liaise with teachers around social/emotional/personal issues with individuals and groups of students and provide support, and/or referrals.
- Supporting teachers with managing students with additional needs, developing EAPs and IEPs in collaboration with teachers and the Enrichment Coordinators.
- Working inclusively so that all students have the most opportunity to be in their class and receive additional support as required.
- Keeping accurate documentation of program delivery, NCCD and IEPs.
